**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF CORNELIA VIEIRA CONCERNING THE
MAILING OF THE POSTCARD NOTICE, E-MAIL NOTICE, WEBSITE, AND
REQUESTS FOR EXCLUSION RECEIVED, AND OBJECTIONS SUBMITTED**

I, Cornelia Vieira, declare as follows:

1. I am a Project Manager at Strategic Claims Services (“SCS”), a nationally recognized class action administration firm. I have over eight years of experience specializing in the administration of class action cases. SCS was established in April 1999 and has administered over five hundred and seventy-five (575) class action cases since its inception. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein, and if called on to do so, I could and would testify competently thereto.

2. Pursuant to the Court's Order Preliminarily Approving Settlement, Certifying Class for Settlement Purposes, Appointing Class Counsel and Settlement Administrator, and Setting Schedule with Respect to Notice, Settlement Hearing and Administration, dated as of December 9, 2025 (Dkt. No. 76, the "Court's Order"), SCS was appointed by the Court¹ to serve as Settlement Administrator. I respectfully submit this declaration as a supplement to my earlier declaration, the Declaration of Cornelia Vieira Concerning the Mailing of the CAFA Notice, Postcard Notice, E-Mail Notice, Website, and Requests for Exclusion Received, and Objections Submitted, dated February 6, 2026 (the "Initial Mailing Declaration").

UPDATE ON MAILING OF THE POSTCARD NOTICE

3. As reported in the Initial Mailing Declaration, the notice was disseminated to all 72,438 Settlement Class Members via mailed Postcard Notice, as well as via E-Mailed Notice to 61,802 of those same Settlement Class Members for whom a valid email address had been provided.

4. As reported in the Initial Mailing Declaration, 5,857 E-Mailed Notices had bounced back to SCS as undeliverable, and 754 Postcard Notices had been returned to SCS undeliverable. Of those 754 Postcard Notices that had been returned undeliverable, 61 Postcard Notices had been re-mailed to the forwarding addresses of the Settlement Class Members as provided by the U.S. Postal Service; the remaining 693 Postcard Notices had been skip-traced to obtain updated addresses, and 489 Postcard Notices had been re-mailed to the updated addresses that were obtained via skip-tracing. Since the Initial Mailing Declaration, SCS has received an additional 4,443 Postcard Notices that were returned to us as undeliverable, for a total of 5,197 Postcard Notices returned as undeliverable. Of the additional 4,443 Postcard Notices returned as

undeliverable, the United States Postal Service provided a forwarding address for 9 of the returned Postcard Notices, and SCS mailed another Postcard Notice to the 9 Settlement Class Members at the updated addresses. The remaining additional 4,434 Postcard Notices returned as undeliverable were skip-traced to obtain updated addresses, and 3,327 Postcard Notices were re-mailed to the updated addresses that were obtained. As a result of these efforts, a total of only 440 notices - less than 1% - were unable to be delivered, where no valid email address had been provided or the E-Mailed Notice bounced back and the Postcard Notice was returned undeliverable without a forwarding address, and where no new address was found via skip-tracing. This successful greater than 99% delivery rate of notices represents an excellent result in my experience as a Project Manager in settlement administration.

UPDATE ON WEBSITE AND TOLL-FREE PHONE LINE

5. The Initial Mailing Declaration noted that by January 8, 2026, SCS established the website for this Settlement, www.MarylandContinentalSettlement.com. The website is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The website contains downloadable copies of the following documents: (i) the long-form notice provided as Exhibit 4 to the Settlement Agreement; (ii) the Court's Order; (iii) the Joint Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement, and for Approval of the Form, Manner and Administration of Notice (Dkt. No. 73); (iv) the Settlement Agreement with Exhibits; and (v) the First Amended Class Action Complaint and Demand for Jury Trial (Dkt. No. 24). The Initial Mailing Declaration also noted that on January 8, 2026, SCS made available a toll-free phone number (866-274-4004) to receive inquiries from Settlement Class Members. SCS continues to maintain the website and phone number and to respond to Settlement Class Members' inquiries.

UPDATE ON REPORT ON EXCLUSION REQUESTS AND OBJECTIONS

6. The Initial Mailing Declaration noted that SCS had received five (5) requests for exclusion from the Settlement. Since the Initial Mailing Declaration, SCS has received an additional four (4) timely and one (1) late requests for exclusion from the Settlement, for a total of ten (10) requests for exclusion from the Settlement received. The deadline by which requests for exclusion had to be postmarked was February 23, 2026. An updated list containing the names of the individuals who requested exclusion from the Settlement is attached as **Exhibit A**.

7. To date, SCS has not received any objections to the settlement. The deadline by which objections had to be postmarked was February 23, 2026.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
